
## UAP Law Organized Virtual Seminar on 'Benefits and Challenges of Using Body Worn Cameras by Police'

Munibur Rahman, Deputy Inspector General, Bangladesh Police and Additional Police Commissioner (Traffic), Dhaka Metropolitan Police was a special guest and informed that around 70% of the police use BWCs in the traffic division of DMP. He highlighted that there are benefits of using BWC that include evidence, accountability, and increase of public trust on police.

Mr. Md. Nazmul Haque, former Additional Inspector General, Bangladesh Police, and former Rector, Police Staff College, was chief guest of the event and briefly discussed the use of BWC in Bangladesh.
